

Opinion Writing Activity for Grades K-4

This activity is very flexible and designed to be incorporated into any subject to give students experience with expressing and communicating their opinions—and critical writing standards for elementary school.

Make sure you choose the correct opinion writing worksheet from the options below. Each one was designed to ensure children can write with correct letter sizing and spacing appropriate for their developmental level.

Materials

- Grade-level Opinion Writing Worksheet
- Pencils

Activity

1. Discuss different opinions or incorporate the activity into a story the class has read recently.
2. Have children write their opinion and supporting reasons on the worksheet. Make sure to model how to place words correctly on double lines.
 - For children who can't write sentences by themselves: Let students dictate words for you and you write it, modeling good letter formation and spacing.
 - In Grades 2, 3, and 4, help children write a concluding statement.
3. Share opinions and reasons with the class. Discuss agreement and differences.

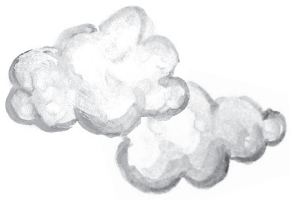

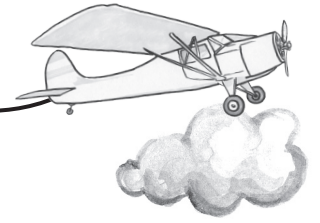
